Social Fermentation

With the series of actions called, "Biological Wisdom and Social Transformation" we ask to what extent can we invent new social forms when turning to the deep wisdom and intelligence that lies in biological systems?

We invite you to join in the second night of our series, *Biological Wisdom and Social Transformation*, which will be held on 27 February simultaneously in different cities and countries including Berlin, Zurich, Helsinki, Tallinn, and Glasgow.

In Berlin this second action will take place **27 February 2015: 18-22** at **Grüntaler9** (Grüntaler Str. 9 13357 Berlin) and is hosted by Luisa Greenfield.

With this project, our overall aim is to connect activist and artist groups working on related questions and to create a trans-local exchange of experience, techniques and knowledge based on the idea of sharing "seeds" generated from within the groups. "Seeds" can be anything – a recipe, a poem, a technique, a task etc. – the only provision is that it is not yet a finished product but instead *activates a process*.

This time we are considering the idea of **social fermentation** and we ask what can we learn from social and activist processes for example in community gardens and alternative residential projects when we look to the process of fermentation.

As a starting point for joint discussion, we will show a combination of shorts- documentary clips about the act of fermentation interspersed with artworks and interviews with artists using fermentation as material and metaphor in their creative practice.

The evening starts at 18 and will include a short introduction, and a collective dinner! The foundational elements will be cooked at Grüntaler but we ask that you also **please bring your canned, fermented, pickled, cultured foods to taste and share**.
